<p>Orientation</p> <p>The narrator tells the audience: <i>who</i> is in the story, <i>when</i> it is happening, <i>where</i> it is happening & <i>what</i> is going on.</p> <p>Tips: * <i>draw specific characters.</i> * <i>Use descriptive words to describe characters and settings.</i></p>	
<p>Complication</p> <p>The narrator tells about something that will begin a chain of events. These events will affect one or more of the characters. The complication is the trigger.</p>	
<p>Sequence of Events</p> <p>The narrator tells how the characters react to the complication. Include their feelings and what they do.</p> <p>Tips: * <i>Use "time" words to connect when events occur</i> <i>eg ...he remembered a time when....</i> <i>...later that day...</i></p> <p>* <i>Verbs show the actions that occur in the story.</i> <i>Eg ...he struggled bravely to...</i> <i>...she glanced back in horror...</i></p>	
<p>Resolution</p> <p>The complication is sorted out and the problem solved. Sometimes the story ends with a moral or message being told, or has a 'twist' at the end!</p>
